## 2026 High Point Series Policy

NTSHA will be trialing a High Point Series for this year. We will award points for placings in select classes at our shows across 2026 and have put together this policy to provide more information and transparency in the points allocations; above all we hope to promote a competitive year while still keeping things fun for our members.

We will award the following categories:

- HP Led Show Horse
- HP Led Show Hunter
- HP Ridden Show Horse
- HP Ridden Show Hunter
- HP Led & Ridden Thoroughbred
- HP Rider Under 18
- HP Rider Over 18

Points will be awarded to current financial members who compete in the following classes per horse and rider combination:

- Led Show Horse / Hunter
- Open Rider age groups
- Open Show Horse / Hunter
- Led & Ridden Thoroughbred \*\*

*\* Led Breed, Fashions and Best Presented classes will **not** earn points. Newcomer, Novice and Intermediate classes will **not** earn points. Placing Champion & Reverse **will** earn points. \**

*\*\* Joint LED & RIDDEN award - Horse & Rider combination must enter **1** led & **1** ridden TB class on each eligible day for points to be counted. This is not split between Hack and Hunter.*
